- KEI will complete your application & forward to the FCC or the frequency coordinator, as is applicable. We will act as a liaison between client and FCC and/or coordinator to make sure your application is processed correctly and answer any questions that the FCC or coordinator may have.
- In the event that your application is rejected by the coordinator or by the FCC, certain coordination/FCC fees may be returned to client. However, KEI's fees will be considered earned.
- Under normal circumstances, it will take at least thirty to sixty days from the time we receive your signed application and fees for the frequency coordinator to process your application. Until then, we have no information to offer in regard to the status of your application. As soon as the frequency coordinator notifies us, we will contact you immediately.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is the final authority in approving or denying your application.
